#Courses marked with a hashtag (#) are courses designated for the nursing major that require a C+ or better for admission and progression in the nursing major. Students must achieve and maintain a CGPA of 2.75.

Repeat Course Policy: Identified Prerequisite Courses (courses marked with #) - Students may repeat only two (2) identified prerequisite courses in which they received a grade of C or below; these courses may be repeated only once. This requirement includes courses taken at other colleges. Students who are required to repeat an identified prerequisite course must achieve a grade of C+ or better in the repeated course. Students who fail to achieve this requirement are not admissible to the nursing program.
