Dear Incoming Students:

Welcome to the NYIT/NUPT joint program! We look forward to your participation as the second cohort in this groundbreaking joint program project between two leading institutions in the United States and China and to working with you as you pursue your educational goals.

The cost for this program is paid to both universities. One part is paid by each student in RMB to NUPT and amounts to RMB18,000 plus additional specific fees paid by all NUPT students. The other part, a registration fee, from each student is payable in U.S. dollars to NYIT and amounts to U.S. \$2,000. This cost sharing has been in place since the inception of the joint NYIT-NUPT program to insure that we meet both Chinese and U.S. academic standards. This year, the costs for the program have increased slightly because of the increased number of international faculty teaching in the program and because of the new opportunities being developed for students from NYIT-NUPT International College to study in New York for one or two years. The breakdown of costs paid to NUPT is listed in the admission notice mailed to every student as is the \$2,000 registration fee to NYIT. This joint program provides you with the unique opportunity to obtain an American-style education and to earn a degree from NYIT—recognized by the Middle States Commission of Higher Education in the United States, as well as a separate degree from NUPT.
