Under the Internal Revenue Code, graduate assistantship funds that are credited to your bursar account for services rendered at New York Tech are subject to income tax and will be reported to you on Form W-2 (U.S. citizens and permanent residents/end of January) or Form 1042-S (international students/mid-March). Additionally, a separate Tuition Statement must be reported to you on Form 1098-T, which may be accessed from your New York Tech account. The Office of Financial Affairs will send out an email notification in January when the form is ready.

NOTE: In order to receive notification of Form 1098-T, you must register your Social Security number with the Registrar's office.

You may want to consult with your accountant or tax advisor to determine if you should be making estimated federal and/or state income tax payments to be in compliance with tax regulations, and to avoid a possible tax penalty for under-withholding.
