Dear Colleagues:

The National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) is currently accepting applications for Summer Stipends via www.grants.gov. Successful applicants receive an award of \$6,000 for two consecutive months of full-time research and writing. The stipends support individuals pursuing advanced research that contributes to scholarly knowledge or public understanding of the humanities, or both. Stipend recipients usually produce articles, monographs, books, digital materials, archaeological site reports, translations, editions, or other scholarly resources. Applicants may be faculty or staff members of colleges, universities, or primary or secondary schools, or they may be independent scholars or writers.

The requirements for nominations have been changed, **and NYIT Faculty no longer need to be nominated in order to submit a proposal. All are welcome to apply. Please send a draft proposal to Juliet Vizbaras jvizbara@nyit.edu by September 5, 2022.**

Detailed application guidelines, including sample proposals, for NEH Summer Stipends and the archived webinar are available at <https://www.neh.gov/grants/research/summer-stipends>. All applications must be created in Grants.gov Workspace in response to the Funding Opportunity Number for the Summer Stipends program, 20220921-FT, and the application must be submitted by the individual nominee via Grants.gov. Before a nominee can apply via Grants.gov, he or she must (a) check their computer's Adobe compatibility at the Grants.gov website (<https://www.grants.gov/web/grants/applicants/adobe-software-compatibility.html>) or download the current version of the Adobe Reader, and (b) complete an individual registration at <https://apply07.grants.gov/apply/IndCPRegister>, preferably at least two weeks before the September 21st full proposal deadline. Prospective applicants who have already registered with Grants.gov as individuals need not re-register to submit their NEH Summer Stipends proposals.

Grants.gov will accept applications for NEH Summer Stipends until 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time on September 21, 2022. The NEH Supplemental Information for Individuals form, which is included in the Grants.gov Workspace package, requires the applicant to specify the names, e-mail addresses, and affiliations of two recommenders. After the deadline, NEH will contact these individuals, requesting that they each write a letter of reference. These letters must be submitted online not later than October 14, 2022. Applicants are responsible for providing referees with relevant materials, such as a draft of the application. (Applicants are also asked to

provide NYIT's Office of Sponsored Programs and Research with a copy of the submitted application and proof of the submission.)

We cordially invite eligible NYIT faculty and staff to apply for NEH Summer Stipend support for the summer of 2023.
