CLINICAL RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

All principal investigators will be required to meet with Arline Allera, the Academic Health Care Center (AHCC) research coordinator, and Joanne Donoghue, AHCC clinical research director, to review safety procedures in the AHCC and Family Health Care Center (FHCC) clinic for their specific protocol.

1. The attached symptom checklist should be completed and signed before any subject is permitted for their visit. This form should be kept in your study regulatory binder.
 - a. Please complete the symptom checklist for yourself prior to working with each subject and file this in the study regulatory binder.
2. Use current campus-specific COVID-19 guidelines from the [Campus Access Policies](#) as designated by NYIT.
3. All investigators will wear either a surgical or N95 mask during all human subject contacts.
4. All human subjects will be required to wear a facemask but nothing with a vent. If the subject does not have a facemask, one will be provided by the clinic. Subjects will be requested to use the provided hand sanitizer before beginning any research activities/procedures.
5. After each human subject leaves, all contact surfaces will be wiped down with germicidal wipes. Contact surfaces include doorknobs, chairs, mats, and other objects with which the human subject or investigator(s) may have come into contact.
6. All subjects scheduled to come to the clinic are REQUIRED to be scheduled with Research Coordinator Arline Allera and kept confidential in the AHCC research calendar.
7. Records of which investigators and human subjects were in contact are to be maintained by the principal investigator in the subject log located in the study regulatory binder.
8. All clinical investigators and other researchers on the protocol including students will be required to complete the CITI training [Covid-19: Back to Campus \(Fall 2020\)](#).
