Scholarship Description

In collaboration with FIRST, New York Institute of Technology is offering two \$500 merit-based scholarships to high school seniors who have been actively involved on a FIRST team and would like to attend New York Tech. This scholarship may be used for a student in any undergraduate program offered in the College of Engineering and Computing Sciences. This scholarship is a one-time award and is in addition to any other scholarship from New York Tech for which students may qualify. Each recipient must meet the regular academic requirements for admission to the college.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a senior in high school
- Have participated on a FIRST team
- Apply and be admitted to New York Tech as a full-time student in one of the following programs:

Computer Science, Construction Engineering, Electrical and Computer Engineering, Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology, Engineering Management, Information Technology, Mechanical Engineering (However, you do not need to have already been admitted at the time you apply for this scholarship.)

- Have a GPA of at least 3.0 (on a scale of 4.0)
- Submit a completed FAFSA to New York Tech

Scholarship Application

To apply for the New York Tech FIRST Scholarship, complete the application package, including:

- A completed New York Tech FIRST Scholarship Application including high school transcript.
- A 500 word essay regarding how your FIRST experience has affected your career goals OR essay describing your FIRST involvement, co-curricular activities and any academic honors.
- A letter of recommendation from an adult mentor/coach on your FIRST team
