Your 2021–2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. In this process, New York Institute of Technology's Office of Financial Aid will be comparing information from your FAFSA with copies of your (and your spouse's or parents', if applicable) tax information as provided by the IRS. The law states that we have the right to ask you for this information before awarding federal aid (CFR 668.51). If there are differences between your FAFSA data and other requested documents, you or New York Institute of Technology may need to make corrections.

1. Please complete, sign, and return this worksheet, along with any other documentation requested by the Office of Financial Aid.
2. If you did not enter your tax information on your FAFSA through the IRS Data Retrieval process or you used the IRS Data Retrieval process and made subsequent corrections to your return, New York Institute of Technology requires you to submit a **Tax Return Transcript**. To obtain a Tax Return Transcript from the IRS, please visit IRS.gov and click "Get My Tax Records." You may also call 800.908.9946 or order one by mail using IRS Form 4506T. (Request for Transcript of Tax Return). There is no fee for a transcript. Non-tax filers may be asked to submit a "Verification of Non-filing" letter by submitting Form 4506-T to the IRS, to which the IRS will then send the non-tax filer a "Verification of Non-filing" letter. The non-tax filer will then send the actual "Verification of Non-filing" letter to New York Institute of Technology.
3. Please submit the transcript to New York Tech's Office of Financial Aid with your full name and student ID clearly marked on each page. Do NOT submit your 1040 forms unless you are requested to do so. If we require any further documentation to complete the verification, you will be notified.

If you have or will file a tax extension, you must submit IRS Form 4868 along with all W-2 forms or a signed statement verifying AGI and tax paid if you are self-employed. New York Tech will maintain a copy of your ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at New York Tech authorized to collect your ID.
