“Commuter Plus” Non Residential Student Meal Plan Contract

June 1, 2018 through May 30, 2019

“Commuter Plus” – This plan is designed for non-residential students who plan to dine in our Retail locations on campus such as Salten Hall, Riland Café, Education Hall, the Sac Servery and the Metro Café.

General Information:

New York Institute of Technology Students with meal plans must take their “One Card” to the dining locations in order to purchase a meal and process payment. “One Card” is accepted by the dining hall cashiers at any dining cash register station.

- Salten Hall, First Floor: Enjoy a hot buffet for both breakfast & lunch. We offer fresh salad and grain bar, a hot food buffet & deli station, fresh fruit and berries, muffins and bagels. As well as made to order omelets and a selection of flavored coffees & cold brew coffee. There are kosher, halal & vegan options available at this café.
- Riland Café, Second Floor: Offers include burgers & omelets. Our buffet features specials of the day, including grilled proteins, fresh seafood, steamed vegetables, salad and grain bar and fresh healthy juices made to order. There are kosher, halal & vegan options available at this café.
- Education Hall, First Floor: Enjoy a hearty breakfasts and a variety of hot food choices including deli sandwiches and paninis, pizza, salad bar, burgers, refreshments, and healthy snacks.
- Student Activity Center: Featuring made to order protein shakes, specialty pizzas & a salad bar. You can also enjoy steak, fish, pasta, burgers and fresh grilled meals. There are kosher, halal & vegan options available at this café.
- 1849 Broadway: Metro Café has a variety of hot food options and specials daily. We provide a selection of flavored coffee, fresh fruit and berries, sandwiches and paninis, salad and grain bar, fresh pizza, an omelet bar and pasta station. There are kosher, halal & vegan options available at this café.

In order to enroll, non-residential NYIT students must add a minimum deposit of \$50.00 to their “Commuter Plus” dining services plan and sign this contract. By enrolling in the “Commuter Plus” meal plan, students save 8.625% tax on the Old Westbury campus and 8.875% tax on purchases made at the Metro Café located at the Manhattan campus.

How to Enroll: Bring the attached form to the Office of the Bursar on your campus to add Funds to your “One Card”. The funds will be added to your student ID card.

Students must sign the “Commuter Plus” contract and submit along with payment. Bursar will load the funds to your “One Card” and you can begin using the funds. We cannot accept payment without a signed copy of this contract.

Payment can be made using cash, money order, American Express, Discover, MasterCard, cashier’s check, or certified check. NO PERSONAL or BUSINESS CHECKS will be accepted for payment of the “Commuter Plus” meal plan.

I accept responsibility for payment of the full cost of the meal plan in the event of withdrawing from NYIT.
