

What is VoiceThread?

VoiceThread is a web-based **interactive tool** for **collaboration** and sharing. A VoiceThread can contain **images, videos,** and **documents,** with or without narration. Viewers can **add comments** using voice, text, audio file, or video.

Why use VoiceThread?

Upload video mini-lectures.

Ask students to pose questions and respond to each other within VoiceThread

Ask questions as they occur.

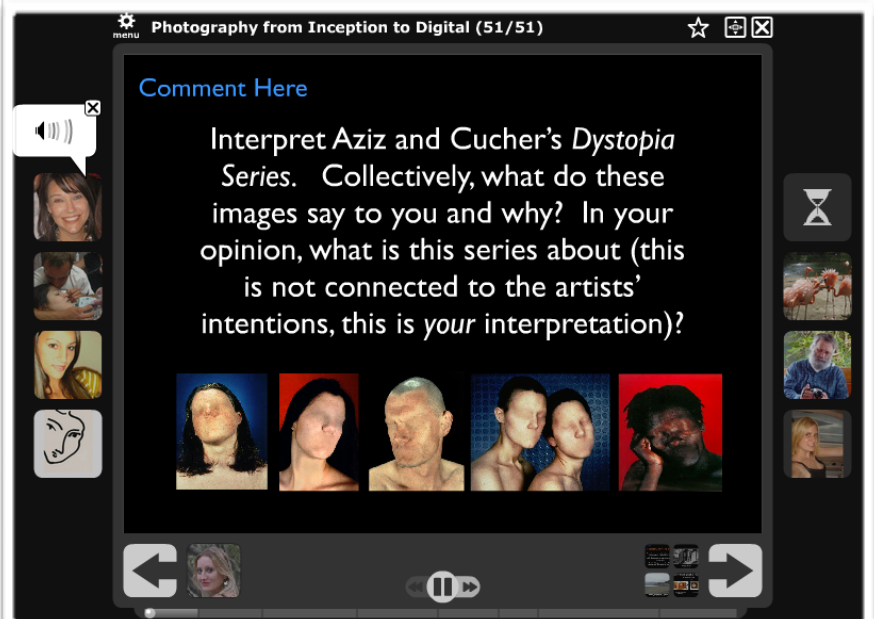
No need to wait and go to a discussion forum to post a question! Students can pause your mini-lecture and insert their questions

Supports active learning.

Students can create their own media-rich presentations and critique each other's work

Enhance student listening, speaking, and writing.

Students can present their projects and practice public speaking, even in an online class

- Upload, share, and discuss videos, presentations, images, audio files, and documents.
- Comment on VoiceThread slides using one of five powerful commenting options: microphone, webcam, text, audio file upload, and phone.
- Seamless integration with Blackboard. Sign in with your NYIT username and password.
- Accessible from Mac/PC and iOS devices.
- Share VoiceThreads as easily as sending an email. Receive notifications for new comments on your VoiceThreads.
