

What is Zoom?

Zoom allows you to **meet face-to-face** with HD videoconferencing. Share the computer screen, **annotate a document**, and even **record the session**.

Why use Zoom?

Meet face-to-face with your students, regardless of location

HIPAA-compliant encryption makes Zoom suitable for clinical supervision

Create a quick screencast for your students

Enables students at remote locations to work together in real-time

Participate in a meeting, even when you can't physically be present



Key Features

- HD video- and audioconferencing for **up to 25 participants**. Teleconference numbers also available
- **Share** your computer screen, **annotate** the document you are viewing, and **record** the meeting for future reference
- Invite people by emailing them a link. Only the meeting host needs an account
- Meet on-demand or schedule meetings in advance
- Works on PC, Mac, Android, and iOS devices
