


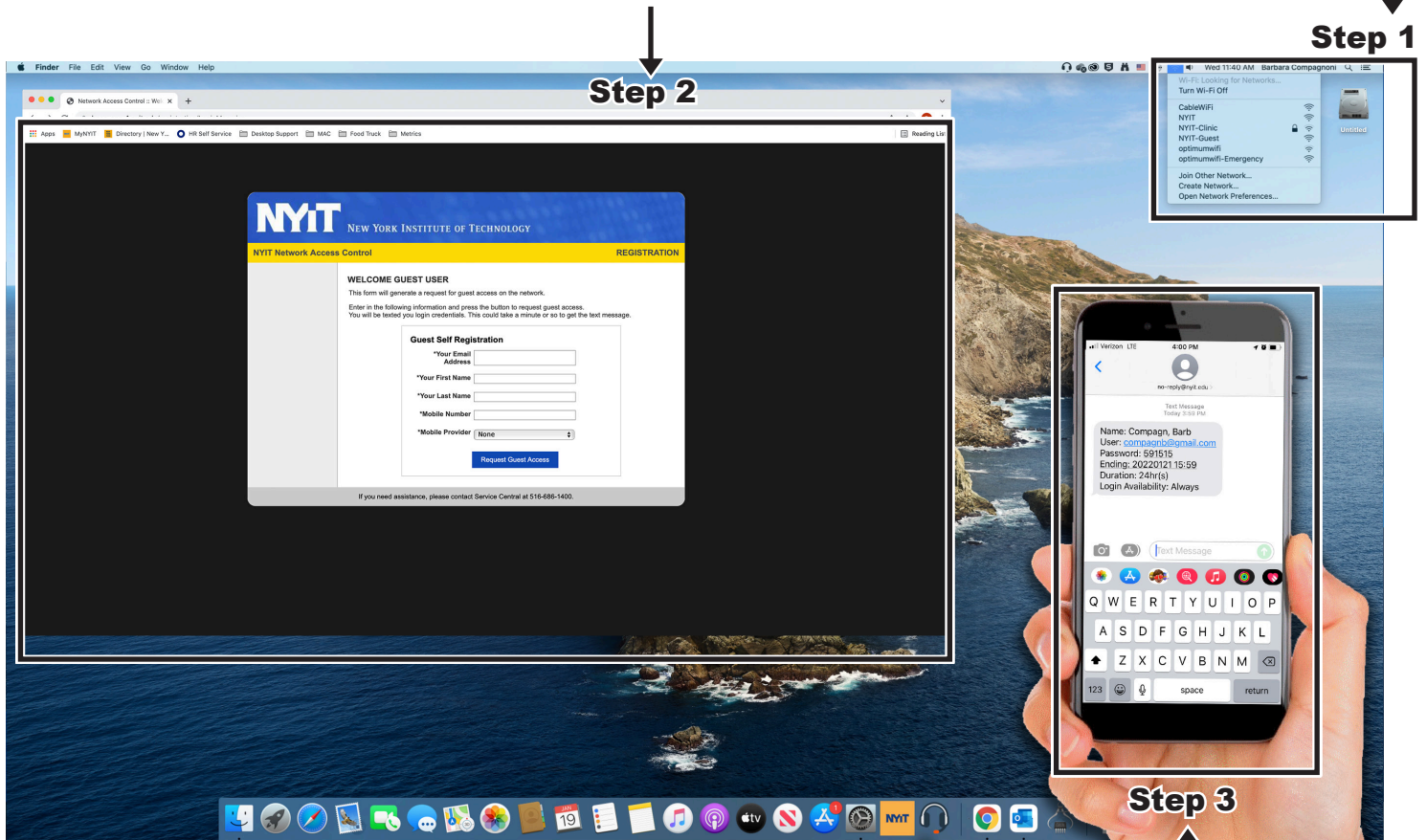
CONNECT TO NYIT-GUEST WI-FI USING MAC OS

STEP 1: Double-click on  and select the **NYIT GUEST Wi-Fi** network from the list of open networks. If you are connecting via an iPhone, make sure **Private Wi-Fi Address** is turned off in the **NYIT GUEST Wi-Fi** network settings.

Please note: All students, faculty & staff should use the NYIT Wi-Fi, NYIT-Guest should only be used for visitors for temporary Wi-Fi internet access.

STEP 2: A browser will open and you will need to follow the prompts to connect. You will need to provide accurate information to complete the process.

*Please note: If you use an nyit.edu email address to register on the NYIT-Guest Wi-Fi, you cannot access any NYIT online resources from the NYIT-Guest Wi-Fi network. Students, faculty & staff who accidentally register for the NYIT-Guest Wi-Fi on your device, please manually disconnect the network and **Forget This Network** if possible.*



STEP 3: You will receive a text message with more information including a number code needed to complete the process. Once you entered the code, you will receive a message that your device is connecting to the network and a progress bar will launch indicating a successful registration.
