## Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration

The New York State problem gambling and chemical dependency HOPEline is owned by the New York State Office of Addiction Services and Supports (OASAS) and operated by contractors to provide high quality, responsive information, and referral services via phone and text message to callers throughout New York State experiencing substance abuse and problem gambling. HOPE line services are free and confidential.

The HOPE line responds to callers and follows-up to ensure that referrals result in intake appointments and to provide support and additional referrals as appropriate. The implementation of a multiple language HOPE line provides callers with access to bilingual staff to provide services in English and Spanish, as well as the 5 other languages that are required by the state of New York (Bengali, Traditional Chinese, Haitian-Creole, Korean, and Russian).
