 - INCLUDE NAME (AND PAGE #) ON EVERY PAGE i.e. SMITH P. 2

FORMAT

- Make it clear, concise and easy to read!
 - If A word or Phrase does not 'Add' anything substantive, Take it out! Do not use vague words such as "various", "several" and "etc." and avoid repetition of words and Phrases.
- AVOID UNNECESSARY AND IRRELEVANT EXPERIENCES.
 - HOWEVER, IF THE EXPERIENCE FILLS IN A <u>TIME GAP</u>, IT SHOULD BE INCLUDED.
- Use strong, descriptive <u>ACTION</u> words (in the CORRECT TENSE):

Triaged, Sutured, Researched, Investigated, Measured, Monitored, Recorded, Documented, Communicated, Presented, Led, Collaborated, Taught, Instructed, Educated, Conducted, Facilitated, Provided, Outreached

- Name and Contact Information
 - Name (Cap, Bold and in Larger Font)
 - Use your name as it appears on your medical school credentials.
 - USE PERMANENT ADDRESS, CELL PHONE # AND EMAIL ADDRESS.
 - BE SURE TO HAVE A PROFESSIONAL VOICE MESSAGE AND EMAIL ADDRESS.

- USING A 'TEMPLATE' OR 'TEXT BOX' FORMAT.
- OMITTING INFORMATION (DATES, DETAILS)
 - ➤ INCLUDE INFORMATION FROM COLLEGE THROUGH MEDICAL SCHOOL IN <u>ALL</u> APPLICABLE CATEGORIES (I.E., WORK EXPERIENCE, RESEARCH EXPERIENCE, HONORS, ACTIVITIES, AFFILIATIONS, COMMUNITY SERVICE) THE <u>ONLY</u> REASON TO LEAVE A HEADING OUT IS IF YOU HAVE <u>NOTHING</u> RELATED TO IT. OTHERWISE, "FILL" ALL SECTIONS TO ENSURE IT IS COMPLETE.
- NOT PLACING ITEMS IN REVERSE CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER.
- NOT SEPARATING INFORMATION INTO SUB-HEADINGS.
- NOT BEING CONSISTENT IN FORMATTING, FONT STYLE, AND SIZE.
- NOT SPELL-CHECKING AND PROOF-READING TO FIND ERRORS.
