For the period, AY22-23, PLOs 1, 2, and 3 are being assessed. Program faculty have updated the matrix. CAPTE Curriculum Evaluative Data criteria have been added to the matrix and will be reflected in all course syllabi as of Fall 2023.

2. METHOD: DESCRIBE THE METHOD OF ASSESSMENT AND ATTACH MEASUREMENT INSTRUMENTS (E.G., RUBRIC, EXAM ITEMS, SCORING GUIDE FOR A PARTICULAR TASK, SUPERVISOR EVALUATION FORM, SURVEY INSTRUMENT, AND OTHER ASSESSMENT TOOLS).

The most remarkable determinants of assessing the PLOs are via student performance on the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE) and based on clinical instructor assessment during and following completion of the student's clinical affiliations, particularly in their final experience. The data collected is from the scores attained by students on the APTA Clinical Performance Instrument (CPI) as assigned by their clinical instructors. The strategic placement of each clinical rotation following an academic year of relevant coursework allows these elements to be formally assessed using this tool.

National Physical Therapy Examination Report from the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy (FSBPT)

Passing the NPTE is the primary rubric for determining the academic program success and competency of program graduates. As per the FSBPT, the NPTE is developed, maintained, and administered "To help ensure that only those individuals who have the requisite knowledge of physical therapy are licensed in the physical therapy field and to help regulatory authorities evaluate candidates and provide standards that are comparable from jurisdiction to jurisdiction" (<u>https://www.fsbpt.org/Secondary-Pages/Exam-Candidates/National-Exam-NPTE</u>).

The graduating cohort of the Class of 2022 achieved a 100% first-time pass rate, meaning all students from the cohort passed the licensing examination the first time they sat for the exam. The national average for the first-time pass rate for 2022 graduates was 85%. In addition, the passing score for the 2022 cohort was 699.9, which exceeded the national average (660.3) by over 30 points. As of the most updated version of the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy report (May 17, 2023), the DPT 2021 cohort has improved its ultimate pass rate from 94.7% to 97.4% with one graduate still outstanding (see official report below).

3. ANALYSIS OF THE ASSESSMENT RESULTS: PROVIDE CRITERIA-BASED DISAGGREGATE AND AGGREGATE DATA ANALYSIS.

Taking a deeper dive into the content areas of the NPTE that align with the PLOs assessed in this assessment period, we can look at the Content Area Reports of first-time test takers in the New York Tech DPT program from 2021 and the 2022 graduating cohort. Using NPTE scores in content areas from previous years will provide a baseline for determining practical outcomes going forward. The content areas aligned with our assessed PLOs are in bold and italics below, with a notable increase in the mean scale score (out of 800) in those content areas from 2021 to 2022:

Clinical Rating Scores on the Clinical Performance Instrument (CPI), assessed at the end of the final clinical rotation On the web-based version of the CPI, the rating scale includes 21 performance intervals, ranging from "Beginning performance" to "Beyond entry-level performance." Each benchmark corresponds to a specific benchmark with the following scores:

- Beginning performance: 1-4
- Advanced beginner: 5-8
- Intermediate: 9-12
- Advanced intermediate: 13-16
- Entry-level: 17-20 (expected score by end of Clinical Education IV)
- Beyond entry-level: 21

A report generated in the web-based CPI yielded the following average scores (out of a possible 21) for the Classes of 2022 and 2023 in the clinical skill areas consistent with the PLOs assessed, based on the completion of their final clinical education experience.

The attached Excel sheet will show individual student scores for the 2022 and 2023 cohorts. Except for one student receiving a score of 16 in Patient Management: Screening (2022), all students in both cohorts received a score of 17 or higher in all Patient Management areas consistent with PLOs being assessed during the AY22-23, indicating the achievement of entry-level skills, as per clinical instructors.

4. INTERPRETATION: TO WHAT DEGREE DID STUDENTS ACHIEVE THE PROGRAM LEARNING OUTCOMES BASED ON YOUR DATA ANALYSIS AND EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES?

Using the outcome measures of the NPTE pass rate, scores in the respective content areas on the NPTE, and the achievement of entrylevel clinical performance benchmarks, all students from the Class of 2022 have shown that they have met the PLOs assessed for the AY 22-23, with the achievement of a 100% first-time pass rate on the NPTE and the achievement of entry-level status on all clinical skills in their final clinical experience. The Class of 2023 has not yet taken the NPTE as of the completion of this report, but similarly to the Class of 2022, all students achieved a clinical rating score of entry-level (17-20+). In summary, both cohorts exhibited an average of 18+ in all clinical skill areas reflected in the PLOs at the end of their final clinical rotations, thus providing objective evidence that students are well-prepared and ready to manage the complex dimensions of patient care.

As per last year's report, the targeted outcomes to be assessed for AY23-24 will be:

- 4. Communicate appropriately and effectively with patients, families, colleagues, and the public.
- 5. Adhere to safe, ethical, and legal practice.
- 6. Apply sound administrative principles to the management of physical therapy practice.
- 7. Apply basic educational strategies for teaching within the scope of physical therapy.

However, it should be noted that next year, the CPI will be replaced with the Clinical Internship Evaluation Tool (CIET), a newer clinical performance tool implemented this year.

II. Brief Description of Faculty Engagement in the Current Annual Assessment Report:

With the regular updating of the program matrix, faculty verify PLOs for courses in which they are primary instructors, thus providing faculty with the opportunity for ongoing assessment of all outcomes annually, not only those specifically identified in this report. With the revision of the program matrix, which now includes all CAPTE evaluative criteria, including curriculum criteria numbers, course syllabi will be modified to include the CC1-CC5 criteria at the end of course objectives by Fall 2023. This will assist in aligning our course objectives with the specific evaluative criteria as we prepare for re-accreditation in 2026.

Once this report has been accepted by the Institutional CPI Committee, it will be disseminated and discussed at the next Department meeting scheduled for August 2023.
