

Canon AirPrint on an iOS Device or Mac

Requirements:

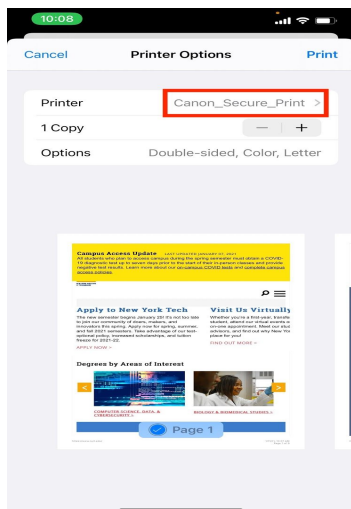
- iPhone and iPad with iOS 14 or higher.
- Mac with MacOS Catalina (10.15) or Later.
- Your iOS device or Mac and the printer must be connected to the NYIT network

Canon AirPrint from iOS device:

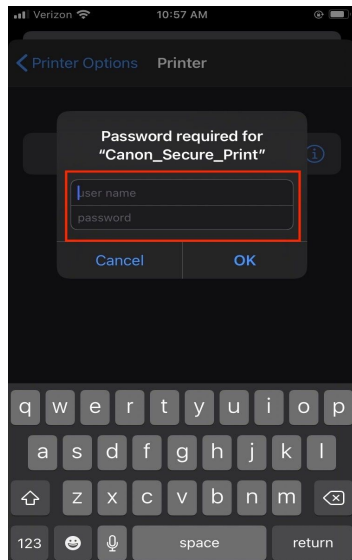
1. Tap the share icon to display menu options for your iOS device.



2. Scroll down and tap the printer icon or Print.
3. Tap Select Printer and choose “Canon_Secure_Print”
4. Tap Print in the upper-right corner.



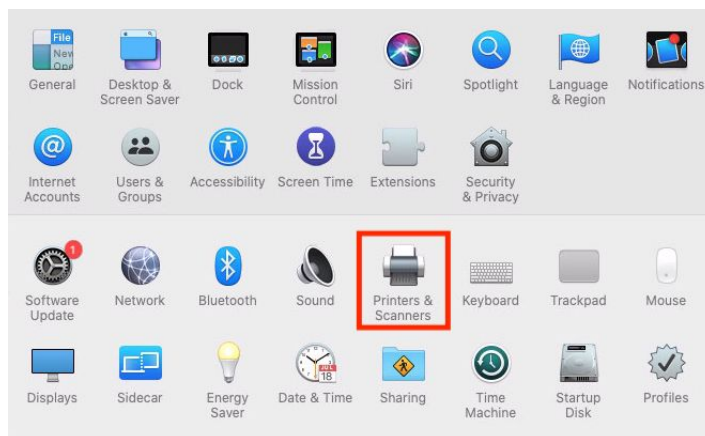
5. Enter you NYIT credentials



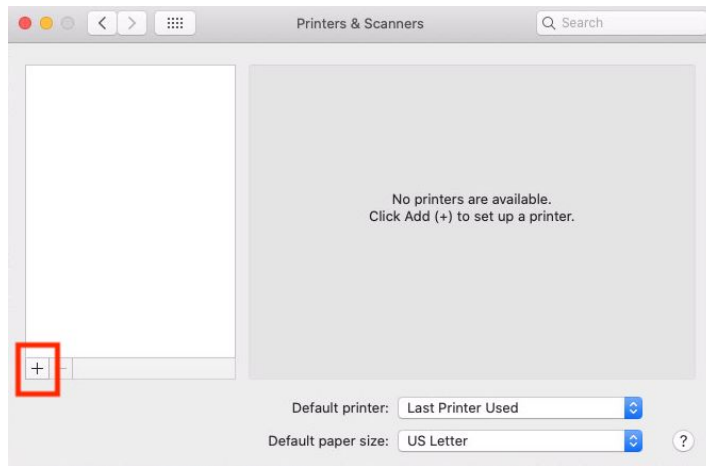
6. Go to the nearest Canon Printer, swipe your ID or Enter your NYIT credentials.
7. Touch the "Secure Print" icon and select the print job you would like to release.
8. Touch "Print and Save" to release the job.

Canon AirPrint from *MacOS* device

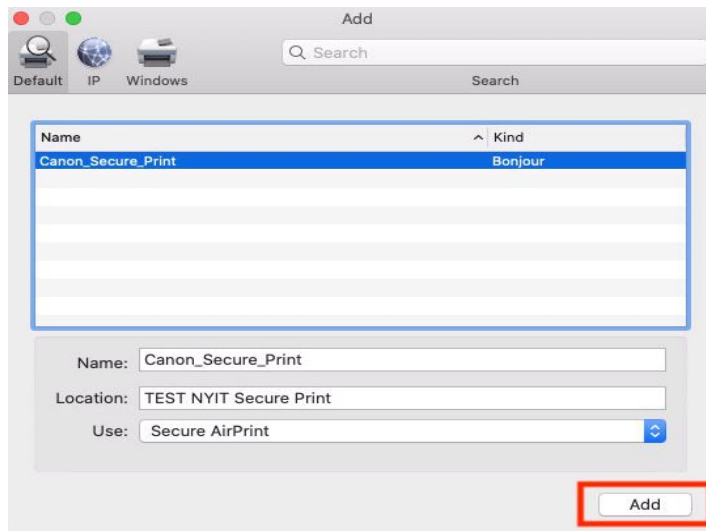
1. Add Canon Secure Print to your MacOS device.
 - a. Go to System Preferences and Click on Printers



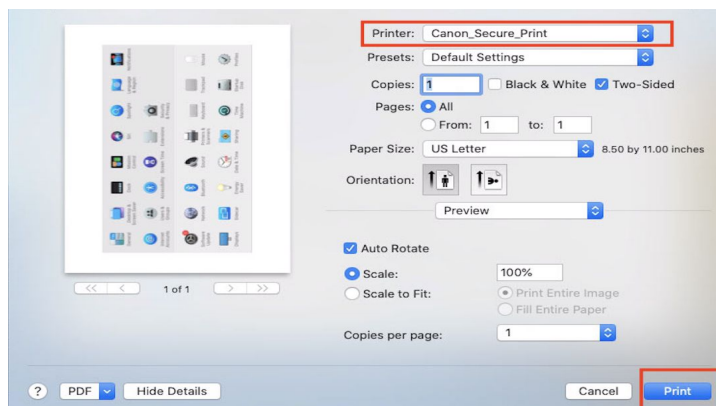
b. Select the “+” in the left corner



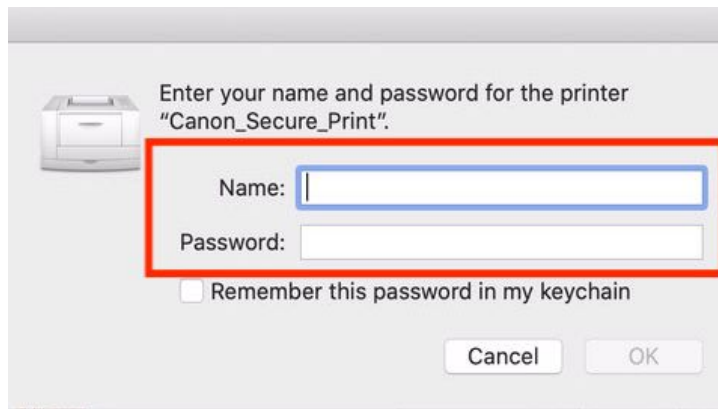
c. Select “Canon_Secure_Print” and click “Add”



2. Choose the “Canon_Secure_Print” from the drop down menu while on campus and select “Print”



3. You will be prompted to enter your NYIT credentials.



4. Go to the nearest Canon Printer, swipe your ID or Enter your NYIT credentials.
5. Touch the "Secure Print" icon and select the print job you would like to release.
6. Touch "Print and Save" to release the job.
